### What we are studying

#### Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on shape and statistics. We will also be looking at reading the time to the nearest minute using an analogue and digital clock. This is an area of maths, that needs lots of practice so any additional support at home with this would be beneficial to help your child to be able to tell the time.

We are continuing to work on our times tables and becoming fluent in them. We will work on our 3,4 and 8's.

We will continue to do regular times tables checks so please keep working on them at home with TT Rockstars which will help prepare the children for the national Year 4 times table test next year, as well as supporting them with their maths work.



### English

During our English this term, we will continue to deepen the children's understanding of the Year 3 grammar objectives such as conjunctions, prepositions and use of adjectives.

We will use a book called 'The Night Gardener' to develop the children's descriptive writing before moving on to learning about non chronological reports. We will link out writing in with our Science unit.

We will begin to recap on previously taught spelling rules, as well as the Year 3 challenge words. Please ensure your child learns their spellings each week and go back over any rules that they may have found tricky.

### What are we learning?

This term, our theme is based around our Science unit which is plants. We will be learning about the parts of the plant and how these help with processes such as water transportation and pollination. We will be hopefully planting some plants of our own.

In Art, we will be looking at formal elements around shape and tone. During our PE lessons, we will be focusing on the skills required for athletics and tennis. Our PSHE theme is 'Changing Me' which looks at realtionships and how we change as we become older.

The children will also look into the local area of Ribchester as part of Geography and will be able to make links to our previous History unit here.
