Maths

This term we will be learning multiplication and division written methods and looking at length, perimeter and fractions.

We are working on the trickier tables x6, x7, x9 and x12. The children need to have quick recall of all of their times tables by the end of year 4.

Please continue to encourage your child to practice their times tables at home. It really does have an impact on their maths learning and confidence when completing Soundchecks on TT Rockstars.

English

In English, we are going to be reading the novel 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. We will be studying the techniques the author uses to create descriptions and use these skills to write descriptions of robots the children will create.

We will also be using the book to help the children to develop their comprehension skills further and to link with our other topics too.

We will continue with grammar and spelling lessons.

History


Our History unit will be all about the Anglo Saxons and Scots. We will be looking at how and when the Vikings came to Britain and fought the Anglo – Saxons, where the Vikings came from, why the Vikings raided monasteries, the attack on Lindisfarne, Viking boats, the agreement of Danelane and how the Vikings were defeated.

Science

During our Science lessons, we will be learning about electricity. We will be developing our investigation skills by planning, carrying out and evaluating investigations linked to circuits. We will also learn why we need electricity and how it can be dangerous.
